New Adverse Weather Policy

If adverse weather is expected to cause hazardous conditions before the SRC opens for business, the President & CEO may make the decision to close for the day. **Some closures may be localized in nature.** To verify an Evergreen closure:

Call the main phone line 303-674-2843

The voice mail will be updated by 4:45 am
If closing is anticipated the day prior, we will remind clients/families to call the main line in the morning.

Now, if SRC is open, up and running, and adverse weather is presenting hazardous conditions, the decision may be made to close the Adult Day program early. If this is the case, we will call families to ask them to pick up their family member early or to alert them that transportation is bringing the client home early. No client, who is unable to stay home alone will be sent home without verbal verification from the family that the client will be arriving home early. If road conditions prevent family members from picking up a client, staff members will keep the client at the site until evacuation can be made to a safe place in the community.

Unwanted Seasonal Guests

With the cold weather arriving, it tends to bring germs with it.
